From the Association's Rules Each member educational institution has the following rights:

- The executive officer has the right to appoint two nominees to represent his/her educational institution.
- At any meeting concerning the EEA Board, only nominees can vote.
- The 16 member Board has a minimum of 12 members from educational institutions.
- As many members as they like may attend or be part of any committee.
- Access to curriculum material is via the association's website and will require password access.
- All members working with youth must meet police checks and mandatory reporting requirements.
