

Guard Rail End Caps



Images from top left hand – top line

- Fish tail end caps
 - The first one shows what it is like as you drive past
 - The second shows the cutting edge of the fish tail
- Solid end caps
 - These are more for stopping vehicles careering off a bridge into a gully. Here it is a the approach to a bridge over a railway line.
- Flat end cap
 - This type has a collapsible structure behind the flat surface as well as bolts, though relatively tight, can absorb some of the impact as they slide forward in slotted holes.
- Round end cap
 - The round end has some strength in its shape being anchored as in an ellipse. On impact the surface will collapse inwards creating a wider surface area to absorb more of the frontal impact of a vehicle.
